YOUR ARRIVAL TO THE HOTEL REGINA IN DETAIL

The Hotel Regina scores with its central location and has an ideal connection to the public transport network. You can safely leave the car at home and enjoy the journey by public transport. Stress-free, without looking for a parking space or garage fees!

The hotel is an ideal starting point for exploring Vienna on foot. The State Opera, St. Stephen's Cathedral and the Hofburg, as well as many other impressive sights, can be easily reached on foot. In just 200 meters you will find the subway station "Schottentor" (U2) or the bus 1A.

Your arrival by public transport

from Westbahnhof:

• Take the U3 in the direction of "Simmering" and get off at the "Volkstheater" station. Please change here to the U2 line in the direction of "Seestadt" and drive four stops to "Schottentor". Then please take the "Schottentor/Universität" exit and immediately after that please take the "Währingerstraße" exit. From this point you can see the Hotel Regina in front of you and you just have to walk through the park.

from Hauptbahnhof:

• Take the U1 in the direction of "Leopoldau" and get off at the "Karlsplatz" station. Please change here to line "U2" in the direction of "Seestadt" and drive four stops to "Schottentor". Then please take the "Schottentor/Universität" exit and immediately after that please take the "Währingerstrasse" staircase. From this point you can see the Hotel Regina in front of you and you just have to walk through the park.

Your arrival from airport Vienna Schwechat

- **Rapid transit** S7 to Wien Mitte (departs every 30 minutes). From there, please take the U4 to the Schottenring station. Here please get on the U2 and drive one station to "Schottentor". Then please take the "Schottentor/Universität" exit and immediately after that please take the "Währingerstraße" exit. From this point you can see the Hotel Regina right in front of you. Take the Vienna Airport Lines "VAL2" bus to "Morzinplatz/Schwedenplatz". From here, take tram 1 in the direction of "Stefan-Fadinger-Platz" to the "Schottentor" stop. From here you can already see the Hotel Regina.
- **CAT** (City Airport Train) every 30 minutes to "Wien Mitte". From there please take the U4 in the direction of "Heiligenstadt" and get off at the Schottenring station. Please change to the U2, direction "Karlsplatz", and drive one stop to "Schottentor". Then please take the "Schottentor/Universität" exit and immediately after that please take the "Währingerstraße" exit. From this point you can see the Hotel Regina right in front of you.
- **Taxi** (costs about 45-50 Euro)

Your arrival with your own car

- If you prefer to arrive by car, you can of course stop in front of the hotel to unload your luggage. Parking in Vienna is subject to a fee on request we can provide you with a day parking ticket for a fee (public parking spaces).
- As a special service, we offer our guests a garage space at a fixed price. We would be happy to email you a detailed map of how to get there.

BARRIER-FREE ACCESS TO HOTEL REGINA

Our hotel building is equipped with a ramp at the main entrance. If you are then in the entrance hall, the following public areas on the ground floor can be reached barrier-free:

• Reception, entrance hall, breakfast rooms, Restaurant Roth, public toilet (straight next to the restaurant), Seminar rooms on the ground floor (Votiv Saal, Salon Alt Wien, Salon Makart).

Our 165 guest rooms in the Hotel Regina vary in size due to the special architecture of the building and have an individual character. They are located on floors 1 to 4 and can be reached by elevator. Due to the special circumstances and construction of our historic house, the rooms are not adequately designed for special needs and accessibility, but our staff is always happy to take care of your concerns and your well-being. The associated bathrooms are fully tiled and equipped with handrails.

All of our hotel corridors (floors) are carpeted and most of the guest rooms have wooden parquet floors.

Our reception, which is located in the entrance hall on the left, is staffed around the clock and of course our employees are there to help you. There is also always a member of staff on hand to help open doors and carry luggage.



Our Restaurant Roth is also on the ground floor. Access is step-free via the main entrance. Breakfast is prepared in several rooms on the ground floor and a wide range of delicacies is offered in buffet form. In summer, breakfast can also be taken in our Roth garden. Of course, there is also the option of having your choice of food served to you at the table or straight to your room.

We are pleased that our hotel is also barrier-free for celebrations and barrier-free meetings. The seminar and event rooms are located on 3 levels and, if they are not on the ground floor, can all be reached with a lift. 3 seminar rooms are carpeted, 2 of them with wooden parquet floors. The toilets on each level are also barrier-free.
